Paul Goodwin is the Artistic Director of The Shakespeare Edit, a classical theatre company committed to bringing vivid productions of Shakespeare to the international stage. He teaches and directs Shakespeare for both professional actors and students in the UK and internationally. From 2008-2017 he was the Course Director of MA Acting at Drama Centre London, one of the foremost postgraduate training courses in the UK. He spent 30 years as a professional actor, working at the Royal Shakespeare Company, National Theatre and Cheek by Jowl, as well as other companies nationally and internationally.
